The T-CYSA Jamboree is designed to provide **recreational players** (competitive players will not be allowed to play) a tournament environment in a fun, low-pressure format. This year's Spring Jamboree is open to boys and girls recreational teams U6 through U14 and will be held on May 8th, 2010 at the T-CYSA Soccer Complex in Pasco, Washington.

Each team is guaranteed a minimum of three games: All three games played on Saturday.

Entry fees are \$80 for U6-7, \$110 for U8, \$130 for U9, \$160 for U10-14. All players and head coaches (1 per team) will receive a t-shirt. U6 and U7 players will also receive a medal.

Registration

Jamboree rosters and fees must be postmarked no later than **April 24th, 2010**. Team application must include a roster with Player state ID#'s. Please submit a roster from your association registrar (safe team roster) that has this information on it as well as identifying that all players and the coach are compliant with the new concussion law which is required. Rosters must be signed by the team's association registrar; T-CYSA team rosters will be signed by the T-CYSA Registrar after they are submitted. The T-CYSA Registrar will verify rosters. A team will only be accepted into the Jamboree upon receipt and verification of the roster.

Each team is allowed up to 3 guest players. Guest players must be valid registered players with Washington Youth Soccer and need to be identified on the roster. T-CYSA teams must submit a written permission (emails are acceptable) from the coach releasing his/her players to be guests on your roster. Guests cannot be rostered without this release. Email releases can be sent to the T-CYSA Office (office@t-cysa.org). T-CYSA teams may also include these written releases with the registration form when it is submitted.

ONLY THOSE COACHES WITH A CURRENT WSYSA RISK MANAGEMENT CLEARANCE WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER A TEAM IN THIS JAMBOREE.

Jamboree Rules

The basic rules of play shall be FIFA rules and interpretations currently set forth in its publication "Laws of the Game and Universal Guide for Referees", except as specifically modified below. In matters of judgment, the referee shall be the sole authority, and the referee's decision shall be final.

Players' Equipment:

All **T-CYSA teams** are **required** to wear regulation T-CYSA uniforms (no exception). The home team will wear the blue jersey. Shin guards are required. Before the start of the match, the referee shall ensure that each player's equipment is in proper order and that no player is wearing anything that may endanger that player or other players. Protective Orthopedic devices and any equipment, gear, appliance or apparatus that is protective for a known medical condition may be worn during a game provided that the referee determines that the device conforms to Law 4 of the Laws of the Game.

Team listed first on the schedule will be the home team. Home teams have the choice of sidelines.

Special Rules for U6 and U7:

Free substitution is allowed, but play will also be stopped midway through each half for substitutions. The referee should stop the game clock during these intervals and restart it when the game resumes.

Special Rules for U6, U7, and U8:

Teams should identify and bring their **own referees** as they do for league play. Referees are not provided for these age groups.

The goal/penalty area is delineated by the 6-yd line, which extends across the field.

Infringements that occur within the goal/penalty area result in an indirect kick from the nearest point on the 6-yd line.

All opposing players must be at least 6 yards from the ball on free kicks, corner kicks, kick offs, and goal kicks.

Team Check-In

Coaches need to check in their teams at the main office of T-CYSA at least 30 minutes prior to their first game.
